Post only pdf files!

Many types of files (such as docx) cannot be opened when posted. To download a good **free** pdf writer go to <http://www.cutepdf.com>. Once downloaded, the cutepdf writer will appear in your list of printers. Print your document in the usual way, but choose the pdf writer as the printer. You will be prompted to name and save the new pdf file. This is the version of the file you will post in your e-Portfolio. Note: some word processing software allows you to simply save your document as a pdf file.

It is **highly recommended** that you have a classmate double check that your URL link is correct and that your files can be easily located and opened. Since the ePortfolio assignment is due at nearly the end of the term, your instructor will only have time to check for it once. Be sure link is correct, the project is actually there, it is in pdf files that can be opened, and that it is correct.

Your project and reflection must be posted in your e-Portfolio and linked in your MyPage account by **30 April 2013**.
