### **Course Description**

The Textiles Course provides students with a basic knowledge of textiles: production, performance characteristics, and an understanding of textile components—including fibers, yarns, fabrics, and finishes. Students will learn how to recognize specific fabrics necessary to fulfill day-to-day responsibilities in many careers in the textile, apparel, and interior design segments of the global textile industry.

Recommended Prerequisite: FASH 1010 or taken concurrently.

Semester: Fall & Spring

- Demonstrate an understanding of textile vocabulary terms associated with the fashion industry and a fluency in their use.
- Demonstrate a basic knowledge of textile components, constructions, manufacturing, and finishing processes.

 Identify basic types of fibers, yarns, textiles, dyeing and printing processes and finishes.

Identify the construction and names of a core group of fabrics.

• Demonstrate knowledge of the proper end uses of textiles in apparel design

applications.

Demonstrate a basic knowledge of textile care and labeling requirements.

• Compare and contrast the interrelationships among fiber, yarn and textile

construction components and their impact on product performance.

 Demonstrate an understanding of consumer and environmental issues and concerns, including the effects of globalization and sustainability on the textiles

industry.
