Course Description

Fashion Draping is the process of positioning and pinning fabric on a dress form to develop the structure of a garment design. A designer drapes a garment by using a design sketch as a basis, or instead arranges the way the fabric falls to create a new design. After draping, the fabric is removed from the dress form and is used to create a garment sewing pattern.

Prereq: FASH 1505 with concurrency, and FASH 1100 with a C grade or higher

Semester: Fall & Spring

Course Student Learning Outcomes

- Demonstrate an understanding of the process for preparing the dress form for garment draping.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the process for creating garments by applying draping techniques in the development process.
- Demonstrate an educated understanding of construction techniques and sequence for creating a garment prototype.
- Demonstrate an educated understanding of fit analysis and application of construction corrections for the garment sample.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the process for completing a “finished” garment that includes linings and facings.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the process for creating final patterns.
- Demonstrate the ability to reflect and communicate effectively by articulating all parts of the garment design process.
- Demonstrate an educated understanding of fit analysis and application of construction corrections for the garment sample.
