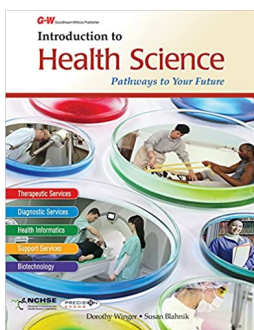
Keys for Success (how to succeed in the course)
