Course Description

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A body system approach covering medical word roots, suffixes, and prefixes. Emphasis is placed on pronunciation through use of the textbook audio files, spelling, and proper usage of medical terms. Medical abbreviations are also introduced as it relates to Health Professions.

- Remember and identify over 350 different prefixes, word roots and suffixes.
- Demonstrate the correct spelling of over 350-word roots and medical terms.
- Define and diagram over 350-word roots and medical terms.
- Identify and define over 300 common medical abbreviations.
- Identify and define common medical abbreviations.

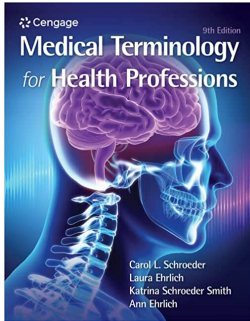
