Course Student Learning Outcomes

- Explain the Nursing Role related to implications of Pharmacology through the application of the Nursing Process with emphasis on medications used for increasingly ill patients.
- Describe the role of the professional registered nurse in drug administration related to lifespan issues, transcultural beliefs; safety and the prevention of medication errors.
- Prioritize appropriate patient teaching regarding drug therapy that considers developmental stage, age, culture, and spirituality.
