

Air Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Program TEAC 1990 HVAC Externship

Course Description:

Externships are an opportunity for students to apply the skills and knowledge they have obtained throughout the program. It is the student's responsibility to arrange the externship with an employer within the HVACR industry. If the student is already employed in the HVACR industry, a letter from their employer stating the type of work/tasks that they routinely perform and the length of their employment will fulfill this requirement.

Grading and Evaluation:

Each assignment, quiz, and exam has an assigned point value. The course grade is determined by summing all of the assignments, quizzes, and exams and dividing the sum by the total possible points. A letter grade is determined using the percentage of points earned and the following grading standard:
