Course Description

Foundations of Accounting is an introduction to basic financial and managerial accounting concepts for business decision making. This course emphasizes the interpretation of accounting concepts that underlie basic financial statements. In addition, it covers accounting equation analysis, profitability, short-term decisions, and capital budgeting.

- Create business budgets for forecasting decisions.

Brief Description of Assignments/Exams

Homework

Practice Assignments exist to help you prepare for your homework assignments. You have unlimited attempts at these assignments and are graded on accuracy. There is a guided video to walk you through each of these assignments to make sure you get 100%.

Foundation Assignments are question sets graded on accuracy. You have one attempt at each assignment but can check your answer twice on each question before your score is graded.

Talking Points Quizzes are multiple-choice question sets covering the most important concepts from each level's material. Look at the Talking Points page in each level to get an idea of what will be on the quiz. You have unlimited attempts on these quizzes and they will help you prepare for the final exam.

Discussions are included in most of the weekly modules. For each discussion, you are required to make one initial post that addresses the prompt and at least one reply to another student. Replies that simply state

"I agree" will not be counted. **Discussions will have points deducted if not submitted on time.** This is the only assignment with a late penalty.

Interim Exams

There are three module exams in the course. These exams are taken online in Connect and consist of a mixture of multiple-choice and workout problems. Exams are not timed. There is a required practice exam to help you prepare for each test.

Module exams are open book and open note. Students are expected to take the exams independently.

Each exam can be taken twice.

If an exam is taken twice, only the higher score will count.

Final Exam

The final exam is a set of multiple-choice questions taken at the end of the semester. The exam is comprehensive, meaning there are a few questions from each unit we covered. This exam focuses on the concepts found on the Talking Points pages that appear in each module. The best way to prepare for this exam is to review the Talking Points pages and practice with the Talking Points Quizzes. This exam must be taken in an SLCC testing center and an appointment is required in advance. For Fall 2025, the exam period is December 15 - 18. If you cannot test on campus during this time, alternate arrangements must be made in advance, so please contact me.

Extra Credit Assignments

In each level, there is an assignment labeled Side Quest. For this assignment, complete your workbook and take a few pics/video to show completion. Or, if you do not have a workbook, take some pictures of your notes. This earns extra credit and helps prepare you for assignments and exams!
