Course Description

This course will introduce the principles and techniques of hand drafting, as well as the procedures and standard requirements of efficient space planning for residential and commercial interior design. Programming and schematic design development will be used in developing drawings typical for an Interior Design project.

Course Student Learning Outcomes

- Demonstrate proficiency in hand drafting skills.
- Develop conceptual and schematic drawings.
- Demonstrate the ability to think visually and volumetrically.
- Create entry level industry standard drawings for interior design documentation and communication, including: floor plans, furniture plans, elevations, schedules, electrical, and reflected ceiling plans.
- Recognize the drawing types, symbols, and navigation used in a typical set of architectural construction documents.
- Apply creative and critical thinking skills to the development of an interior design project.
- Utilize efficient space planning techniques incorporating building codes and correct clearances for physical and mental well-being.
- Synthesize information through programming (interpreting client needs) to create an interior design project.

• Demonstrate professional discipline through time management and organizational skills.

Engagement Plan

Example language:
